DISPOSE OF ALL UNUSED DRUGS AT MEDICATION DROP BOXES!

24/7 Medication Drop Boxes and Syringe Disposal

Drop off unused and unwanted medications any time at these police department lobbies. Prescription, over-the-counter and pet medications are accepted (**no liquids, please**). You may keep them in the containers or place pills in a sealed plastic bag. **Do not dispose of sharps (lancets, needles, syringes) in medication drop boxes.** See below for sharps disposal sites.
